We sincerely foresee that the youth/women of our country have tremendous potential and hence they should be availed with maximum possible opportunities for their success. Along with this, the Society also aims at mobilizing social welfare and protecting public interest. Apart from educational and social activities, the Society prudes into various other programmes of social interest like welfare of women and children in remote areas/medical relief activities etc.

The Society gives prime importance to the human resource of the country and emphatically believes that if the people of this country were healthy and educated, it would surely enhance the chances of their growth.

The activities done in the year 2008-09 are mentioned as follows:

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Being a rural area the financial condition of the students is considerably weak. Hence, our Society organized programmes like distribution of school uniforms, exercise books, stationary and other educational material to the students so that they may not face any problems while pursuing their education.

SELF-EMPLOYMENT CAMPAIGNS

In the month of April, a Self Employment Camp was organized by the Society. Self-employment for the youth is the need of the hour. In the Camp, the youth & women were informed about various Professions such as Computer operations, Beauty Parlour, Fashion designing, motor driving and Technical training which are available for the youth. Self-employment opportunity for the youth has increased through such campaigns. They were given valuable information regarding various departmental schemes for self-employment of youth like, the Agricultural Department, Khadi Gram Udyog, District Small Scale Industries, D.I.C and several other schemes for self-employment for the youth. All the schemes were elaborately explained to youth. Participants expressed gratitude for organizing such thought provoking, self-estimating and fruitful campaign.

PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT SESSIONS

A Personality Development Session was organized by the Society for the unemployed youth of Dist: Akola. Many dignitaries of various fields were present for the guiding the youth on different personality aspects. The Lecture series was on the following topics such as "Leadership" "Confidence" "Career-Building" "Qualities in Youth" "Team Work". Etc.

EMPLOYMENT & SELF EMPLOYMENT CAMP

The Society has organized employment and self employment camp for Scheduled Caste and Schedule Tribe (SC & ST) community unemployed youths and adolescent girls who after getting higher education are wandering in search of jobs. The said program encourages the youths to get trained in different vocational trades and to start their own small-scale units or to get gainful employment in private or public sector.

CELEBRATION OF WORLD HANDICAP DAY

On the occasion of World Handicap Day i.e. 8th December 2008 we distributed the free medicines and fruits to the poor handicap students at "Indrayani Handicap School, Akola". This programme was organised by our Society with the contribution of the members.

HEALTH GUIDANCE CAMP

The Health Guidance Camp was organised with a view of preventive measures for prevention of epidemic diseases during the rainy season. The Camp was organised in the remote area of Akola, which is a backward rural area. The participant villagers were explained about water-borne diseases like Cholera, Malaria, Dysentery, Pneumonia, and Jaundice etc. They were told that in the rainy season water of the hand pumps becomes yellow and polluted due to the dung stored in pits around the village residential areas. In order to avoid the pollution of water due to manure pits, such manure pits should be prepared away from the drinking water sources. In the rainy season water should be used after chlorinating or boiling it. Importance of individual hygiene was emphasized by exhibiting pictures. Stale food was told to be avoided in the rainy season. Spraying and dusting of DDT powder in the open space to avoid the effect of flies was advised.

Many other similar Programmes in Public Interest, Educational, Cultural and Social Welfare were organized by our Society.
