ANNUAL REPORT

2017-18

Our Society has been striving hard to cater to the needs of education in rural / tribal youth & students Since its inception in 1992. to give them a separate identity of their own by promoting and enhancing the potentialities in their personalities, so that they would be strong enough to face the challenges of life and time.

Our organization works with people who reside in very remote areas away from the mainstream, developmental facilities, education and primary medical facilities. Journey of our organization began in 1992 for the people from the remote parts of rural and tribal areas of AKOLA DISTRICT; mainly those from the economically backward classes such as farmers, workers, laborers', agricultural laborers who depend upon uncertain wages and belong to unorganized sector, underprivileged youth, women and malnourished children.

Apart from this there are a number of need-based events and activities are undertaken from time to time at regular intervals during the year. The Annual activity report of the financial Year 2010-11 is as follows:

AIDS AWARENESS DRIVE

The Society had arranged numerous Poster and painting Exhibitions in and around the rural arenas of AKOT Taluka. These Exhibitions aimed at spreading the word of mouth regarding AIDS Awareness. School and College Children participated in the Exhibitions. The Exhibition was made open to all free of cost.

SOCIAL FORESTRY AND TREE PLANTATION PROGRAMME

A social forestry and Forest Act Awareness camp was organized by our Trust so that the people should realize the importance of conservation of Forests & wild animals. Tree-plantation was a major programme conducted in which at least 600 saplings were planted by the villagers. The rights and duties towards the protection of Forests were also explained to the public by reputed Forest officials.

SPORTS COMPETITIONS AND CONTESTS

Our Society organized various Sports Competitions all round the year as a part of academic development and all round personality development of the rural students. The various competitions include debates, elocutions, extempore speeches, group discussions etc. Various contests such as Fancy Dress Contests, Drawing /painting Competitions, Sports contests and Quiz Contests . These competitions were arranged in order to give the rural students a feel of the Competitive Environment.

EMPLOYMENT & SELF EMPLOYMENT CAMP

The Society has organized employment and self employment camp for Scheduled Caste and Schedule Tribe (SC & ST) community unemployed youths and adolescent girls who after getting higher education are wandering in search of jobs. The said program encourages the youths to get trained in different vocational trades and to start their own small-scale units or to get gainful employment in private or public sector.

EDUCATIONAL GUIDANCE CAMPS

Our Society runs educational guidance camps for rural / tribal women so that they understand the importance of literacy and education. The Society strives that women from nearby villages avail the opportunity of Basic & Primary Education from this Education Center. This is a way to curb ignorance and Illiteracy. Traditional and illiterate labour class women and girls coming from economically backward classes of society are provided basic education and made literate. Hence these condensed courses are like 'a big boon in small pockets' to the illiterate women.

WOMEN GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING MEETS

Guidance and Counseling Meets were conducted on 2nd January 11 in order to generate awareness among the rural women to fight the injustice they face and to give them an insight into their own constitutional rights. Our Society sincerely strives for the welfare of distressed women and provides them with services like crisis intervention, avoiding dowry deaths, counseling in cases of marital family maladjustment etc. The Society dedicatedly intervenes in matters to strengthen the social fabric by preventing the families from breaking.

MEDICAL HEALTH SCRUTINY CAMPS FOR WOMEN & CHILDREN

The Society conducted Medical Check-ups and Counseling Camps in the rural areas for women and children. They were counseled on personal hygiene and sanitation. They were also given free medical advises as well as free medicines to get rid of their respective ailments. Particularly Women were the target audience.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Being a rural /tribal / tribal area the financial condition of the students is considerably weak. Hence, our Society organized programmes like distribution of school uniforms, exercise books, stationary and other educational material to the students so that they may not face any problems while pursuing their education.

HEALTH CAMPS

The Society conducted a Health Camp in villages like Malkapur , Khadki, Alanda (Dist: Akola) respectively. The Camp included speeches on protecting the family from various water-borne diseases like Cholera, Jaundice etc. as well as contagious diseases like Pneumonia, Chicken-pox and Scabies etc. The basic objective of this Camp was to make the rural women as well as citizens about the prominent and contagious diseases that hamper health conditions and bring misery and death and provide remedial measures for preventing the same.
