Since the inception in 1992, our organisation is contributing in Social work

We sincerely foresee that the youth / women of our country have tremendous potential and hence they should be availed with maximum possible opportunities for their success. Along with this, the society also aims at mobilizing social welfare and protecting public interest.

Our Society has been functioning independently for social causes, Health, Educational, Legal awareness, Agriculture as well as multifaceted objectives of rural reform. The Society's endeavours in the past year i.e. 2020 - 2021 are remarkable. Some of them are as follows.

AWARENESS ACTIVITY FOR FARMERS

The society arranged a Farmers guidance camp at Dapura Majlapur on 25 March 2021 for the farmers in and around Akola. The objective behind this camp was to create awareness among the traditional farmers regarding the use of modern techniques in farming and the upcoming trends in modern farming. In coordination with National Bamboo Mission, the Bamboo Tissue Culture Plantation is beneficial for Farmers. Agriculture Office Shri Gajanan Garole sir and Cluster head Jagannath Warghat guided and explained the importance of scientific means of farming and methods of getting higher yields. The Experts also emphasized on the information & implementation of the various Central and State Government schemes of National Horticulture Boards, Floriculture, Vermiculture, Organic farming and Medicinal plant cultivation. Even techniques of green manure and compost manure preparation were explained.

MIGRANT LABOURS SURVEY IN COVID 19 PANDAMIC

In March 2020, the Government of India announced a national lockdown to contain the spread of the disease. This crippled our economy, leaving millions unemployed and displaced. In response to the resulting health and humanitarian crisis, our organisation did the survey of migrant labours in Akola and Washim district under the guidance of AFARM, Pune.

The outbreak of COVID - 19 and problems out of it , CEO, NITI Aayog, AFARM Pune and Our organisation worked to combat COVID -19 on war-foot and help the helpless and peoples in distress.

Our organisation distributed tea and snacks and dry food grains to 70 families of Jagjivanram nagar, the outskirts area of Akola city on 04, 08, 09 March 2020.

COVID - 19 pandemic several labours were migrated from one place to another, from cities to their native places, among them are skilled, semiskilled, unemployed youth, small business man. The survey was done in two phases in August 2020 and in November 2020 by AFARMA Pune with our organisation in Akola and Washim districts.

SANITATION COVID 19

The COVID 19 Pandemic has hit Maharashtra and curve went rising. Under the guidance and support of Maha NGO Federation Pune, Face mask were distributed to Corona Yoddhas at Ashok watika square, Akola on 24 Sep. 2020, Homeopathic Medicine Arsenic Album 30 was distributed to the Labours working in MIDC Area at B K Square, Akola and on the Eve of Mahatma Gandhi's Jayanti a Madaticha Hath Activity, School material distributed to students at Wani Rambhapur. Our organisation arranged Gram Swachhta Abhiyan on 02 Oct. 2020 on the eve of Gandhi Jayanti at Ganesh Nagar, Kumbhari with the help of local residents. Sarpanch and Grampanchyat members and school teachers were present.

DE-ADDICTION CAMPAIGN

Drug de-addiction Campaign was inaugurated in the city on 31st May 2020, 'No Tobacco Day' is also celebrated. The One-day campaign run, in which Shri Ghodeswar Sir, Ravindra Kawade and Shri Balaji Pawar.

Dr S. Patil said tobacco had become the gateway to drugs in youth. Youngsters start with smoking and then gradually shift to even more harmful drugs out of various socioeconomic and family reasons.

Dr Kelkar also highlighted the on-going campaigns of Sevadharna NGO wherein a large number of volunteers are offering their selfless services across the Akola district to help innocent youth fallen in the evil trap of drugs.

During meditation, certain hormones are secreted in the body that are responsible for cheerfulness, happiness and increase in tolerance power. Our organisation got the valuable guidance and support from Social worker, Counsellor and Motivator Shri Ramchandra Waghmare Sir, Sarathi Youth Foundation Solapur.

HEALTH AWARENESS

The Organisation conducted a Health camp in the villages , Ghusar, Ghusarwadi and Apatapa in Akola tehsil on 17 Jun. 2020 camp include speeches on protecting the family from various waterborne diseases like Cholera, Jaundice etc. as well as contagious diseases like Pneumonia and scabies etc.

The basic objective of this camp was to make the rural women as well as citizen about the prominent and contagious diseases that hamper health conditions and bring misery & death and provide remedial measures for preventing the same.

As a part of social welfare activities, the organisation also held an AIDS Awareness activity for the Truck drivers and labour class working in the industrial area of Akola city. These people were given information in respect of Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STD) and Reproductive Tract Infections (RTI) and its use to pervert themselves from diseases. Rehabilitation courses for those suffering from any sexual disorders were conducted in order to save their lives from the deadly diseases. Inputs regarding HIV / AIDS and the ways to prevent it were emphasized.

Good Touch & Bad Touch

Talk on Good Touch & Bad Touch an interactive talk session was done on 22nd January, 2021 to aware students of class 7th to 10th at Kanya Vidyalaya, Mothi Umari Akola. All the required things related to the topic were discussed among the target group. All the students participated in the discussion will be full zeal. After then videos related to this were also shown as to give them more clarity towards the issue. Famous Educational Videos such as of Satyamev Jayate - Child Sexual Abuse, Educational movie - KOMAI shown. In the starting students were feeling shy to talk about it but later after encouraging then they slowly opened up. In the question answer round was done as to clear the doubts of the students and send them home was a positive impact of the topic. Advocate Anamika Hande guided the girls.

ROAD SAFETY CAMPAIGN

National road safety week is celebrated from 11th January to 17th January every year in our country India to create awareness about road safety and minimize road accidents & save life. This year we are celebrating 32nd National Road Safety Week.

March 4 is observed every year as National Safety Day in India with the purpose of creating awareness among people with respect to safety measures. The day seeks to increase awareness about all guidelines, which includes road safety, workplace safety, and the safety of human health as well as the environment. This year, the focus of National Safety Day is on road safety and the theme is '*Sadak Suraksha*' (road safety).

Our organisation celebrated Road Safety Week observed from March 4 to March 10, in order to highlight the importance of safety on the roads and Displayed the Banners in Akola city at prominent places, Petrol Pump at Mount Carmel School square, at Ashok watika chowk, Ratanlal plot chowk, Civil line chowk, Doke petrol pump at Chhoti Umari and at Agrawal petrol pump at national highway, Murtijapur road.

ENTREPRENEUR ACTIVITY

Organisation had conducted Business Mentoring camp for the youth and women of rural area of Balapur tehsil of Akola district at Wadegaon on 28 March 2020 with a view to enrich and strengthen the economic position of the youth. So the organisation has arranged this campaign. Skill Development Coordinator Shri Farkade sir and Shri Ingle sir guided us. The youth and women were taught Computer application, Computer typing, Carpentry, English and Marathi Shorthand, Tailoring and cutting and Dress designing with an intention to make them self-sufficient and self-reliant.

ENVIRONMENT AWARENES

Our organisation is running Jalkranti Abhiyan since last year. We run Jalkranti Abhiyan to know the value and asset of water. This Abhiyan is being run the guidance of Shri Suhas Sohoni Jaltandnya, Amravati. Rainwater harvesting is important because we are facing water scarcity. Rainwater is an economical way to save water and prevent rainwater wastage. The Rainwater harvesting is done using two methods. One is surface runoff harvesting and the other is rooftop rain water harvesting. On 05 Jun 2020 the Abhiyan was organised at Ghusarwadi, Shri Suhas Sohoni and Shri Bharad sir guided the villagers.

We are also associated with Help Institute for Natural Development (HIND), Neknoor, and Bhir.

SELF HELP GROUP AWARENESS

Our organisation arranged the Sheti Shala for the Kharip Crops at Saykhed on 02 Jun 2020 on the farm of Shri Baban Ingle. Agriculture Expert Shri Gajanan Garole guided the farmers regarding the crops like cotton, soybean, Jowar, Udid and Mung.
